Kyushu University is seeking an experienced individual with expertise in teaching and research for appointment as one tenured Professor in the International Development Section, Institute of Tropical Agriculture.

Institute of Tropical Agriculture, Kyushu University is one of the joint-use facilities of the university, and involves in conducting research, education and international cooperation on tropical agriculture with three sections, Tropical Crops and Environment Section, Land-Water Resources and Environment Conservation Section and International Development Section. The International Development Section where the recruitment of a professor is offered is dealing with research on international development of forest and local village, and conservation of forest environment in tropical regions. The professor of the Section participates in the education of master's and doctoral course programs as Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Global Society, and lectures the undergraduate students in School of Agriculture and School of Interdisciplinary Science and Innovation.
